

If you have antibodies against the virus that causes COVID-19, or have had a prior positive test, it does not mean you are definitely immune.



A prior positive test (nose swab or saliva) means you have had COVID-19 & may be less likely to be re-infected. We don't know how strong the protection is, or for how long it lasts.
