Central Certificate Ceremony:

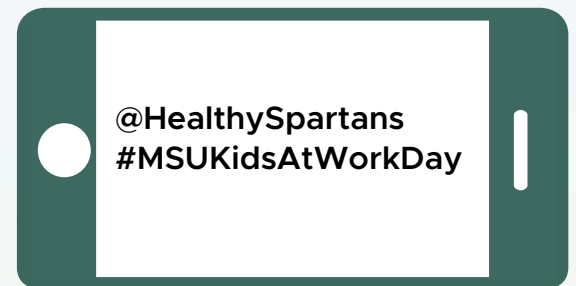

Our tour includes a 45-minute walk behind the scenes where nuclei are accelerated, filtered and/or studied. The secrets we learn could help explain what happens in supernovae and the origins of elements that make up the human body.
 - Please note: The tour route is completely handicap accessible and safe for those who may be pregnant or have medical implants.
